Infection Control (Revisited): Avoid Being the Next Dentist Poster Child!

What if oshA or the Dental Board show up at your practice tomorrow during the busiest part of your day? Picture your office at its worst. That is likely the condition your office will likely be if you ever endure an inspection because of Murphy's law - what can go wrong will (and at the worst possible time). Murphy is alive and well in the dental profession!
